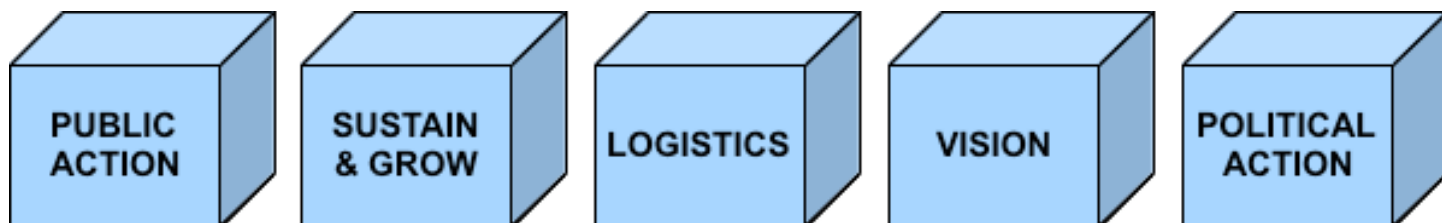


# Ideas for Occupy Los Lunas

The central difference of opinion among the folks at the 11/20 OLL event was between those who wanted to articulate goals and take specific political actions and those who didn't. The important point is that both can be done simultaneously with no conflict.

Here are a proposed set of functional units. A lot of it is already being done informally without being labeled. This is non-hierarchical and preserves all current activities.



Each of these could have a designated “reporter” - with a backup, if available - to provide a brief status report online and at the beginning of each general assembly. Anyone could belong to any or all of these groups. Some proposed responsibilities for each of these follow:

## **PUBLIC ACTION**

- ❖ Schedule and manage demonstrations
- ❖ Provide national Occupy movement communication and coordination
- ❖ Provide public education through dialog, leaflets, etc.

## **SUSTAIN & GROW**

- ❖ Collect and track member information
- ❖ Recruit new members and allies (e.g. unions)
- ❖ Manage media communication and press releases

## **LOGISTICS**

- ❖ Identify event sites
- ❖ Secure any needed permits and permissions
- ❖ Make signs
- ❖ Manage internal communication with members
- ❖ Oversee resource issues

## **VISION**

- ❖ Identify consensus goals by soliciting essays and testing themes with everybody
- ❖ Articulate and provide philosophical justification of these themes and goals
- ❖ Suggest general paths to realize the consensus goals

## **POLITICAL ACTION**

- ❖ Define an action plan, drawing from Vision research and other available options
- ❖ Execute the plan
